Finca El Encial Crianza



The winery:

Finca El Encial winery was founded in October 2000 and is located in the town of Quintana del Pidio (Burgos, Spain). It is part of one of the strongest Spanish family wine groups, Bodegas Franco Españolas, which is also present in the top Spanish wine & spirits appellations: Rioja, Sherry and Brandy de Jerez.

Finca El Encial is one of the most modern wineries in the prestigious RIBERA DEL DUERO wine region.

Finca El Encial Crianza:

Fermentation is done at an average temperature of 88° F.

This wine ages 20 months in medium-toast American oak casks, making the traditional racking (“trasiego”) from cask to cask every five months.

It has a dark cherry color with touches of roof tile. It is very complex with hints of fine woods and spices. This very ample and hearty wine has well-balanced tannins. Overall, it is very elegant and persistent.

Capacity: 750 ML.

Alcohol content: 12.5% by vol.

Grape Variety: Tinta Fina.

Aging: Twenty months in American oak cask.

Racking every five months.

To be consumed at: 61 - 64 °F
